Bookmark "Un petit air de Holden"

Note: this work was realized to be offered with a shawl Holden realized on the occasion of a swap.

This bookmark has a freely inspired motive for the shawl create by *Mindy Wilkes*, to reach the pattern of the shawl, *Click Here*.

Material:

Needles 3mm

Wool

Point and abbreviations:

k: knit

p: purl

K2tog: knit 2 together

SSk: slip, slip, knit: Slip next 2 stitches knitwise, one at a time, to right hand needle. Insert tip of left hand needle into fronts of these stitches from left to right. Knit them together. One stitch has been decreased. <u>a good video there</u>.

Yo: Yarn Over

st: stitch

Work:

Cast on 17 st, knit 4 rows, then:

Rows: 1, 3 and 5: knit

Rows 2, 4, 6, 8 and 10: k2, p13, k2.

Row 7: k2, SSk, k9, K2tog, k2 (15st)

Row 9: k2, SSk, k7, K2tog, k2 (13st)

Row 11: k2, SSk, Yo, (k, Yo)x5, K2tog, k2 (17st)

Row 12: k17

Repeat rows 3 to 12 as many times as you want, then knit 2 rows and bind off in picot points (see the way to do it there)

If you want to add pearls, do it on the k on the row 11, (you can see the way to do here).

Bring in the threads, block the bookmark, and cut the threads.
