Beanie Aldaran

Matrerial:

1 ball of Odin, circular needles 6mm or 4 needles, stitch marker, cable needle, row counter, tapestry needle.

Points and abbreviations:

k:knit

p. purl

st: stitch

m1: make 1 and knit it

m1p: make I and purl it.

SKP: slip, knit and pass the slip stitch over.

SK2P: slip 1, knit 2 together and pass the slip stitch over.

K2tog: Knit 2 stitches together.

P3tog: Purl 3 stitches together.

...: knit the motive between *...* as many times as necessary to finish the round.

R: round

T1, with 2 stitches:

Method without cable needle: prick the second stitch from behind and knit it without passing on the right needle, then knit the first stitch and then let the two stitches pass on right needle.

Method with cable needle: put the first stitch on the needle placed in front, knit the next stitch, take the first from cable needle and knit it.

T2, with 8 stitches: put the 4 first stitches on the needle placed in front of the work, knit the 4 following stitches, take the stitches from cable needle and knit them.

Gauge (stocking stitch, 10cm/10cm): 20 rows/14 stiches.



Work:

Cast on 72 st. in long cast tail, put the stitch marker to indicate the beginning of the round and form the circle, start to knit ribs:

R 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 9,10, 11 and 13: *k2, p1*

R4, 8, 12: *T1, p1*

Body of the beanie:

R1: *k1, m1, k3, m1, k1, m1, p7* (90 st.)

R 2: *k8, p7*

R 3: *k8, m1p, p7, m1p* (102 st.)

R 4 and 11: *T2, p9*

R 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 12 and 13: *k8, p9*

R 14 and 15: *k8, p4, k1, p4*

R16: *k8, p3, k3, p3*

R 17: *T2, p3, k3, p3*

R 18 and 19: *k8, p2, k5, p2*

R 20, 21, 22 and 23: *k8, p1, k7, p1*

R 24: *T2, p1, SKP, k3, K2tog, p1* (90 st.)

R 25 and 26: *k8, p1, k5, p1*

R 27: *k8, p1, SKP, k1, K2tog, p1* (78 st.)

R 28: *k8, p1, k3, p1*

R 29: *k8, p1, SK2P, p1* (66 st.)

R 30: *k8, p1, k1, p1*

R31: *T2, P3tog* (54 st.)

R 32: *k8, p1*

R 33: * SKP, k4, K2tog, p1* (35 st.)

R 34: *k6, p1*

R 35: *SKP, k2, K2tog, p1* (30 st.)

R 36: *4md, 1mv*

R37: *SKP,K2tog, p1* (18 st.)

Cut the thread at 30 cms long, fix the top of the hat, bring in the threads and cut them short.
