Flower Coasters Pattern







Supplies : cottons like Capri of Katia, Phil'Coton 3 of Phildar, Sunny of Cheval Blanc... Technique : crochet hook size n°3 (US English terms)

- Start with 6 chains (ch). Join into a ring by a slip stitch (ss).
- 1st round: Crochet 15 double crochet (dc) in the ring. End each round by 1ss in the first stitch.
- 2nd round: 2dc in each stitch, so you have 30 stitches at the end of the round.
- 3rd round: repeat 6 times [2ch, skip next stitch, single crochet (sc) in next 4 stitches]
- 4th round : crochet in the 6 holes [3dc, 2ch, 3dc] + 1ch between each petal.
- 5th round: 12dc in the 6 holes made by the last 2ch + 1ss in hole between each petal.
- 6th round: sc in next 4 stitches, repeat 4 times [2sc in one stitch], sc in next 4 stitches + 1ss in hole between each petal.
- Fasten off.





Yarn : Cotton Cord of Katia (shade ecru) Technique : crochet hook size n°6

- Start with 9ch. Crochet sc all around this chain with 3sc in each endstitch. End each round by 1ss in the first stitch. You have a round of 18 stitches.
- 2nd round: sc + 3 increases in each endpoint (=24).
- 3rd round : sc + 4 increases in each curve (=32).
- One round of sc picking in backloop. Then 6 rounds of sc in the usual way.
- Next round : sc with 2 times [5ch + skip next 4 stitches] to do handles.
- Last round : sc with 6sc in each hole. Fasten off.
