

Soie Belle !

Beret size 57/59 cm around the head, drooping. Wear it behind or on the side, depending on your mood. The rotating and embossed pattern gives full measure to the [Breeze](#) thread, a ribbon with 61% silk that catches the light in all colors.

Material :

2 balls of [Breeze](#), Kremke

Circular needles 5mm and 6mm, 1 stitch marker, scissors, yarn or tapestry needle and rest of contrasting yarn for provisionnal cast on. (for cast on option 1).



Points and abbreviations :

st : stitch

k : knit

p : purl

Yo : Yarn over.

K2tog : knit 2 stitches together.

P2tog : purl 2 stitches together.

SK2P : slip 1, knit 2 stitches together and Pass over

m1 : make 1 : knit the front strand , then, without letting the knitted stitch slip, and knit the back strand.

* ... * repeat the indication between * and * as many times as necessary to go to the end of the round.

Gauge : needles 6mm, 10/10cm : 24 rounds/18 stitches.

Work:

Cast on option 1: With the rest of contrasting yarn, make a provisionnal cast on of 76 stitches and knit in the round. Knit 4 rounds with 5mm needles. Then take your [Breeze](#) yarn and knit 26 rounds as follows : *k2, p2*.

Then, fold the ribs inwards and knit the stitches of the first round with the [Breeze](#) yarn opposite (so as to make a kind of "hem"), making a round according to the following pattern: *k2, p2*.

After finishing this round, remove the provisionnal cast on of contrasting yarn.

Or, Possibility 2: Cast on directly and loosely 76 stitches with the 5mm needles and [Breeze](#) yarn, and knit 26 turns as follows: *k2, p2*. Then continue the pattern following the directions below and after finishing the beret fold the ribs in 2 inwards and make a flexible and discreet seam in [Breeze](#) thread to stabilize the base of the beret.

Still with the 5 mm needles, once the ribs are finished, continue:

increase round 1: * m1 * (152st)

increase round 2: * k3, m1 * (156st)

With 6mm needles, start knitting the following rounds:

Round 1 : *p3, Yo, k4, K2tog, k3*

Round 2 : *p3, k1, Yo, k4, K2tog, k2*

Round 3 : *p3, k2, Yo, k4, K2tog, k1*

Round 4 : *p3, k3, Yo, k4, K2tog*

Repeat these 4 rounds in total 7 times and go to the decreases:

Round 1 : *P2tog, p1, Yo, k4, K2tog, k3* (143st)

Round 2 : *p2, k1, Yo, k4, K2tog, k2*

Round 3 : *p2, k2, Yo, k4, K2tog, k1*

Round 4 : *MV, k3, Yo, k4, K2tog * (130st)

Round 5 : *p1, Yo, k4, K2tog, k3*

Round 6 : *p1, k1, Yo, k4, K2tog, k2*

Round 7 : *p1, K2tog, Yo, k4, K2tog, k1* (117st)

Round 8 : *p1, k2, Yo, k4, K2tog*

Round 9 : *p1, Yo, k3, SK2P, k2 * (104st)

Round 10 : *p1, k1, Yo, k3, K2tog, k1*

Round 11 : *p1, k2, Yo, k3, K2tog *

Round 12 : *p1, Yo, k3, SK2P, k1 * (91st)

Round 13 : *p1, k1, Yo, k3, K2tog *

Round 14 : *p1, K2tog, k4* (78st)

Round 15 : *p1, K2tog, k3* (65st)

Round 16 : *p1, K2tog, k2* (52st)

Round 17 : *p1, K2tog, k1* (39st)

Round 18 : *p1, K2tog* (26st)

Round 19 : *K2tog* (13st)

Cut the thread to 15cm, put it on a yarn needle, pass the thread through all the remaining stitches, remove the circular needle and tighten the thread. Repeat the operation 2 times taking all the stitches each time, bring the thread inside the hat. Tie a small knot through a stitch on the inside. Bring in the thread and cut it.

Bring in and cut the other threads. Blocking is not necessary.
