Edelweiss

Wrap

Material:

5 balls of Mérina (50g/100m), color Naturel.

1 ball of <u>Solfège</u> (50g/300m).

Needles8mm, and /or a circular needle 8mm.

A wool needle.

Points:

<u>Pearl Ribs :</u>

Row 1(right side): one selvedge stitche, knit all.

Row 2 (wrong side): one selvedge stitche, purl1, * knit 1 double, purl 1*, repeat from *to* finish with knit 1.

Repeat always these two rows

To knit double, please see this video, in French, but you will understand easily what to do! <u>knit double.</u>

Finish in the point of tooth:

At the beginning of the row: prick the right needle between the first 2 stitches of the left needle.

Roll up the thread around the right needle, highlight the stitch so created and place it in front of those of the left needle, on the latter.

Repeat the operation once again.

Then, bind off 4 plain stitches.

Place the stitch which is on the right needle on that of the left and to repeat the operation.

So that all this is more clear, I invite you to consult without moderation this very clear pattern !

<u>Work</u>

Cast on 83 stitches with Mérina double thread, and Solfège: you will have 3 threads.

Knit in pearl ribs up to 33 cms in height

Then, **on the wrong side:** one selvedge stitche, purl 1, * knit 1 double, then purl two times the next stitche: Once by the back stalk and once by the stalk before *, repeat from * to*, knit 1.

You obtain 127 stitches.

Knit the next right side row.

On the next wrong side row: one selvedge stitche, purl 1, * knit 1 double, purl 2 *, repeat from * to*, knit 1.

On the next right side row, bin off with the point of tooth.

Make the sewing side, bring in the threads, cut them to short and wear!

NB: the size which I give suits well in a size 44/46(French size) and more (ribs is very elastic).

If you wish a smaller size, take up to 16 stitches less, and proceed in the same way for the work.

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
