## On the road of Snowdonia,

## Bandana Cowl.



This collar pass knits in the choice with the straight needles from the beginning to the end or with straight needles then with circular needles, you can choose the way of making which suits you best.
It begins by the point, the notes of the pattern are to follow line by line.
Materiall:
1 skein of Silk Blend, Manos del Uruguay, color Atlantic
Needles 4mm,
Circular needles 4 mm with a cable of 60 cm ,
A row compter (optional),
A cable needle.
Abbreviations:
k : knit
p: purl
sl : selvedge stitch (slip the first stitch of the row, knit the last one.)
PI : do an increase and purl this stitch.
Inc : do an increase.
(...) : Number of stitches at this level of the work.

Twists: These twists knit on 4 stitches.
T1: Slip 2 stitches to cable needle hold to back, knit 2, knit 2 from the cable needle.
T2: Slip 2 stitches to cable needle hold to back, knit 2, purl 2 from the cable needle.
T3: Slip 2 stitches to cable needle hold to front, purl 2, knit 2 from the cable needle.
T4: Slip 2 stitches to cable needle hold to front, knit 2 , knit 2 from the cable needle. Gauge: ( $2.5 \mathrm{~cm} / 2.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), (1inch/1inch), stocking stitch: 5st/9rows.

## Work:

On the straight needles 4 mm , cast on 4 stitches.
Rows 1 (right side row) and 2 (wrong side row) : k4.
Row 3: k1, Inc, k2, Inc, k1 (6)
Row 4: k2, p2, k2
Row 5: k2, Inc, k2, Inc, k2 (8)
Row 6: k2, p4, k2.
Row 7: k2, PI, p4, PI, k2 (10)
Row 8: k3, p4, k3
Row 9: k2, PI, p1, T1, p1, PI, k2 (12)
Row 10: k4, p4, k4
Row 11: k2, PI, p2, k4, p2, PI, k2 ( 14)
Row 12: k5, p4, k5
Row 13: k2, PI, p1, T2, T3, p1, PI, k2.(16)
Row 14: k4, (p2, k4) x2
Row 15: k2, PI, T1, p4, T4, PI, k2 (18)
Row 16: k3, p4, k4, p4, k3
Row 17: k2, PI, p1, k4, p4, k4, p1, PI, k2, (20)
Row 18: (k4, p4) x2, k4
Row 19: k2, PI, (T2, T3) x2, PI, k2 (22)
Row 20: k3, p2, k4, p4, k4, p2, k3.
Row 21: k2, PI, p1, k2, p4, T1, p4, k2, p1, PI, k2. (24)
Row 22: k4, p2, k4, p4, k4, p2, k4.
Row 23: k2, PI, p2, T4, T2, T3, T1, p2, PI, k2 (26)
Row 24 : k5, p6, k4, p6, k5
Row 25: k2, Inc, p3, k2, T3, p4, T2, k2, p3, Inc, k2 (28)
Row 26: k2, p1, k3, p2, k2, p2, k4, p2, k2, p2, k3, p1, k2.
Row 27: k2, Inc, k1, p3, k2, p2, T3, T2, p2, k2, p3, k1, Inc, k2. (30)
Row 28: k2, To knit stitches as they appear and to finish by k2. Proceed so for all the wrong side rows until the end of work with the straight needles.
Row 29: k2, Inc, k2, Inc, p3, k2, p4, T1, p4, k2, p3, Inc, k2, Inc, k2.(34)
Row 31: k2, Inc, k4, Inc, p3, (T3, T2) x2,p3, Inc, k4, Inc, k2. (38)
Row 33: k2, Inc, k6, Inc, p5, T3, p4, T2, p5, Inc, k6, Inc, k2 (42)
Row 35: k2, Inc, T4, T1, p7, T3, T2, p7, T4, T1, Inc, k2 (44)

Row 37: k2, Inc, k9, p9, T1, p9, k9, Inc, k2 (46)
Row 39: k2, Inc, k2, Inc, k8, p7, T2, T3, p7, k8, Inc, k2, Inc, k2 (50)
Row 41: k2, Inc, k4, Inc, T1, T4, p7, k2, p4, k2, p7, T1, T4, Inc, k4, Inc, k2 (54)
Row 43: k2, Inc, k6, Inc, k8, p7, k2, 4mv, k2, p7, k8, Inc, k6, Inc, k2 (58)
Row 45: k2, Inc, k16, p7, k2, p4, k2, p7, k16, Inc, k2 (60)
Row 47: k2, Inc, k1, (T4, T1)x2, p7, T3, T2, p7, (T4, T1)x2, k1, Inc, k2 (62)
Row 49: k2, Inc, k2, Inc, k16, p9, T1, p9, k16, Inc, k2, Inc, k2.(66)

## Continuation of the model knit in the circular needles:

Round 51: create 32 stitches knit, k2, Inc, k4, Inc, k16, p7, T2, T3, p7, k16, Inc, k4, Inc, k2, create 32 stitches knit, put a stitch marker.(134 stitches)
Round 52: (close the circle), p34, k22, p7, k2, p4, k2, p7, k22, p34.
Round 53: (T1, T4) x7, p5, T1, p4, T4, p5, (T1, T4) x7
Round 54: k56, p5, k4, p4, k4, p5, k56.
Round 55: k56, p3, (T2, T3) x2, p3, k56.
Round 56 and all the odd rounds knit stitches as they appear
Round 57: k56, p3, k2, p4, T1, p4, k2, p3, k56.
Round 59: (T4, T1)x7, p3, T4, T2, T3, T1, p3, (T4, T1)x7.
Round 61: k56, p3, k2, T3, p4, T2, k2, p3, k56.
Round 63: k56, p3, k2, p2, T3, T2, p2, k2, p3, k56.
Round 65: (T1, T4)x7, p3, k2, p4, T1, p4, k2, p3, (T1, T4) x7.
Round 67: k56, p3, (T3, T2) x2, p3, k56.
Round 69: k56, p5, T3, p4, T2, p5, k56.
Round 71: (T4, T1)x7, p7, T3, T2, p7, (T4, T1)x7.
Round 73: k56, p9, T1, p9, k56.
Round 75: k56, p7, T2, T3, p7, k56.
Round 77: (T1, T4) x7, p7, k2, p4, k2, p7, (T1, T4) x7.
Rounds 79 and 81: k56, p7, k2, p4, k2, p7, k56.
Round 83: (T4, T1) x7, p7, T3, T2, p7, (T4, T1)x7.
Round 85: k56, p9, T1, p9, k56.
Round 87: k56, p7, T2, T3, p7, k56.
Round 89: purl
Round 90: knit
Round 91: purl
Round 92 : bind off flexibly.Bring in the threads and block slightly the work. Cut the threads to short, wear!!!

## Continuation of the model knit in the straight needles:

Row 51: create 33 stitches knit, k2, Inc, k4, Inc, k16, p7, T2, T3, p7, k16, Inc, p4, Inc, k2, create 33 stitches knit, (136 stitches)
Row 52: sl1, k34, p22, k7, p2, k4, p2, k7, p22, k35.
Row 53: sl1, (T1, T4)x7, p5, T1, p4, T4, p5, (T1, T4)x7, k1.
Row 54: sl1 ,p56, k5, p4, k4, p4, k5, p56, k1.
Row 55: sl1, k56, p3, (T2, T3) x2, p3, k57.
Row 56 and all the wrong side rows: knit stitches as they appear, think about selvedge stitches at the beginning and at the end of each rows.

Row 57: s11, k56, p3, k2, p4, T1, p4, k2, p3, k57.
Row 59: sl1 ,(T4, T1)x7, p3, T4, T2, T3, T1, p3, (T4, T1)x7, k1.
Row 61: sl1, k56, p3, k2, T3, p4, T2, k2, p3, k57.
Row 63: sl1, k56, p3, k2, p2, T3, T2, p2, k2, p3, k57.
Row 65: s11 (T1, T4)x7, p3, k2, p4, T1, p4,k2, p3, (T1, T4)x7, k1.
Row 67: sl1, k56, p3, (T3, T2)x2, p3, k57.
Row 69: sl1, k56, p5, T3, p4, T2, p5, k57.
Row 71: sl1,(T4, T1)x7, p7, T3, T2, p7, (T4, T1)x7 ,k1.
Row 73: sl1, k56, p9, T1, p9, k57.
Row 75: sl1, k56, p7, T2, T3, p7, k57.
Row 77: sl1, (T1, T4) x7, p7, k2, p4, k2, p7, (T1, T4) x7, k1.
Rows 79 et 81: s11, k56, p7, k2, p4, k2, p7, k57.
Row 83: sl1, (T4, T1) x7, p7, T3, T2, p7, (T4, T1) x7, k1.
Row 85: sl1, k56, p9, T1, p9, k57.
Row 87: sl1, k56, k7, T2, T3, k7, k57.
Row 89: sl1, purl and finish with k1.
Rang 90: sl1, knit.
Row 91: sl1, purl and finish with k1.
Row 92 : bind off flexibly.
Sew the cowl, bring in the threads and block slightly the work. Cut the threads to short, wear!!!
