

Shawl « Clair-Obscur »



Material:

Needles 4mm

1 ball of [Kunstgarn](#) color 01(100g/420m),

Stitch markers , row counter.

Abbreviations:

M : stitch marker

sl: slip stitch (slip the stitch knitwise from the left needle to the right)

p: purl

k: knit

m1 : make one stitch [see the tutorial there.](#)

K2tog : knit 2 together

K3tog : knit 3 together

Yo : yarn over

X : number of variable stitches present in the jersey section, where the increases and decreases are made.

(...) x2: repeat the motive between () 2 times.

Points and other informations :

Stocking stitch :

Right side row : knit all stitches

Wrong side row : purl all stitches

Garter stitch : knit all stitches on right side and wrong side rows.

This shawl is triangular; there will therefore be a section of increase and decrease section. It is built with:

- A straight edge with a slip stitch and 3 stitches of garter stitch, it will be represented in purple on the pattern.

- A part of Stocking stitch, represented in green, where will be made the increases and the decreases, the number of stitches of this part is represented by X, because it varies constantly according to the progress of the work.

- The lace part is noted in red, and the number of stitches indicated is only for the lace edge.

Modèle : Les aiguilles de Camille.com. A usage personnel et non commercial.

Increases:

Cast on 19 stitches, knit 4 rows in garter stitch : 4 stitches, M, 1 stitch, M, 14stitches

Row 1:(right side row):sl1, k3, M, kX, m1, M, Yo, K2tog, k3, Yo, k5, Yo, K2tog, Yo, k2.
(16 st in the lace part)

Row 2:(wrong side row) : k2, p14, k2, M, pX, M, k4.

Row 3: sl1, k3, M, kX, M, Yo, K2tog, k4, K3tog, k2, (YoK2tog) x2, k1 (14 st in the lace part)

Row 4 : k2, p10, k2, M, pX, M, k4.

Row 5 : sl1, k3, M, kX, m1M, Yo, K2tog, k3, K2tog, k2, (Yo, K2tog) x2, k1 (13 st in the lace part).

Row 6 : k2, p9, k2, M, pX, M, k4.

Row 7 : sl1, k3, M, kX, m1, M, Yo, K2tog, k2, K2tog, k2, (Yo,K2tog) x2, k1 (12 st in the lace part)

Row 8 : k2, p8, k2, M, pX, M, k4.

Row 9 : sl1, k3, M, kX, m1, M, Yo, K2tog, k1, K2tog, k2, (Yo, K2tog) x2, k1 (11 st in the lace part).

Row 10 : k2, p7, k2, M, pX, M, k4.

Row 11 : sl1, k3, M, kX, M, Yo, (K2tog)x2, k2, Yo, k1, Yo, K2tog, Yo, k2 (12 st in the lace part)

Row 12 : k2, p8, k2, M, pX, M, k4.

Row 13 : sl1, k3, M, kX, m1, M, Yo, K2tog, k3, Yo, k3, Yo, K2tog, Yo, k2 (14 st in the lace part).

Row 14 : k2, p10, k2, M, pX, M, k4.

Note: at the end of row 13 (and row 14) there are the 14 stitches in the lace part, so you can start again in row 1 without problem.

Repeat this pattern until the piece measures approx 90 cm and continue to the decreases.

Decreases:

Row 1:(right side row): sl1, k3, M, kX, K2tog, k1, M, Yo, K2tog, k3, Yo, k5, Yo, K2tog, Yo, k2. (16 st in the lace part)

Row 2:(wrong side row): k2, p14, k2, M, pX, M, k4.

Row 3: sl1, k3, M, kX, M, Yo, K2tog, k4, K3tog, k2, (YoK2tog) x2, k1. (14 st in the lace part)

Row 4: k2, p10, k2, M, pX, M, k4.

Row 5: sl1, k3, M, kX, K2tog, k1, M, Yo, K2tog, k3, K2tog, k2, (Yo, K2tog) x2, k1 (13 st in the lace part).

Row 6: k2, p9, k2, M, pX, M, k4.

Row 7: sl1, k3, M, kX, K2tog, k1, M, Yo, K2tog, k2, K2tog, k2, (Yo, K2tog) x2, k1 (12 st in the lace part)

Row 8: k2, p8, k2, M, pX, M, k4.

Row 9: sl1, k3, M, kX, K2tog, k1, M, Yo, K2tog, k1, K2tog, k2, (Yo, K2tog) x2, k1 (11 st in the lace part).

Row 10: k2, p7, k2, M, pX, M, k4.

Row 11: sl1, k3, M, kX, M, Yo, (K2tog)x2, k2, Yo, k1, Yo, K2tog, Yo, k2 (12 st in the lace part)

Row 12: k2, p8, k2, M, pX, M, k4.

Row 13: sl1, k3, M, kX, K2tog, k1, M, Yo, K2tog, k3, Yo, k3, Yo, K2tog, Yo, k2 (14 st in the lace part).

Row 14: k2, p10, k2, M, pX, M, k4.

Repeat the pattern as many times as necessary to return to the original 19 stitches.

After the 14th row of the last pattern: make 4 rows garter sts with the remaining 19 sts and then bind off; Bring in the threads, block the shawl, cut the threads.

- Knit the stitch on the wrong side row
- Knit the stitch on the right side row, pur lit on the wrong side row
- ∧ Knit 3 together
